



In Ontario, all students must be vaccinated against **nine** diseases to attend school: Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Diphtheria, Tetanus, Polio, Meningococcal, Pertussis (whooping cough), and Varicella (chickenpox), or have a valid exemption to attend school. Parents and legal guardians must track and report their child's

vaccinations to their local public health unit. Reporting helps keep the student's

record up to date. If your child is 16 or older, be sure to ask for their consent before
