

The **NEW Primary Care Central Intake Form** helps you connect to primary care (family doctors, nurse practitioners) and community supports in North Western Toronto.



★ How does it work?

1. Tell Us About Your Needs

Complete the **online intake form** to tell us about your health needs and the supports you may be looking for.

2. We Find the Right Supports

A care navigator will review your information to help you find primary care and other helpful services in your community.

3. Get Connected to Care

When a primary care match is found, you will get a letter with information on how to book your first appointment. For other supports, someone may call you to help link you to the right services.

★ Who can sign up?

Open to anyone looking for a family doctor or NP in North Western Toronto – with or without OHIP.
